Dear Sir,

We were attended by one of the officials of the Anti-Noise-League that you were asked to send one or two of your silencers for motorcycles to Holland.

As we are planning an Anti-Noise-Congress in the near future, we should be too glad to demonstrate your special silencer at our congress. However it is not sufficient to demonstrate only the noise reduction, but we shall also have to show that a power of the motorengine is not materially affected by the addition of the silence.
