To Acoustical Societies and Commissions.

Concerning a Clearing House for information on future events in  
Acoustics which have international interest.

The International Commission on Acoustics decided at its meeting in Rome, May 1969 to establish a Clearing House for information on future events in Acoustics which have international interest. The Commission has decided to consider not only meetings organized by acoustical societies but also meetings organized by other societies and organizations. The meetings to be considered are those where international participation is possible and sought; purely national meetings or national meetings with only few invited guests from abroad should not be included. Particular attention should be given to medium size symposia on specialized items, on which information is usually rare. The information should circulate as soon as possible even in the planning and preparatory stages of an event.

In order to speed up the collection and circulation of the information the Commission has put one of its members in charge of this service: Dr. F. Kolmer.

Dr. Kolmer will collect the information and let it circulate as soon as possible and usually with a maximum of 2 weeks delay after receipt.

Although the information will not be limited to events organized by Acoustical Societies, the Commission has to rely mainly on the activity of Societies and National Committees for receiving the local information.

Dr. Kolmer will circulate the received information by sending it

- a) to the Journals mentioned in Appendix A
  - b) to the Societies which ask for a direct communication.

Other Journals can be added to the list on suggestion of the Societies.

The Societies are therefore kindly requested to cooperate to the success of this initiative by sending to the Secretary of ICA and to dr. Kolmer indication of their willingness to participate to the service and by sending to dr. Kolmer the information on events as they are available.
